

Bible Verses on Financial Breakthrough

Eight Steps for Financial Breakthrough

1. Look for open doors - sin issues and generational sins.
2. Break the mentality and renew the mind with the Word of God of who you are in Him.
3. Stand on God's Word of promises.
4. Declare and Decree God's Word to rebuild your faith in the area of finances.
5. Don't give up - fight and push through – fight against discouragement along with poverty mindset and lack.
6. Sow a seed - each month go higher 11% to 12% to 13% and higher - you cannot outgive God.
7. Command the Enemy to return 7 fold for what he has stolen from you.
8. Have an Attitude of Gratitude - Praising the Lord in all circumstances.

1. **Psalm 24:1** The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it.

2. **Haggai 2:8** 'The silver is mine and the gold is mine,' declares the Lord of hosts.

3. **Psalm 50:10** "For every beast of the forest is Mine, the cattle on a thousand hills."

4. **Job 41:11** "Who has given to me that I should repay him? Whatever is under the whole heaven is mine."

5. **Psalm 104:24** O Lord, how many are your works! In wisdom you have made them all; the earth is full of your possessions.

6. **Acts 4:24** "Sovereign Lord," they said, "you made the heavens and the earth and the sea, and everything in them.

7. **1 Chronicles 29:12** Both riches and honor come from You, and You rule over all, and in Your hand is power and might; and it lies in Your hand to make great and to strengthen everyone.

8. **Psalms 50:12** 'If I were hungry I would not tell you, for the world is mine, and all that is in it.'

9. **Isaiah 45:3** I will give you hidden treasures, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the Lord, the God of Israel, who summons you by name.

Section Two: Scriptures on Biblical Stewardship - bible verses on financial breakthrough

10. **Psalms 115:16** The heavens are the heavens of the Lord, but the earth He has given to the sons of men.

11. **Proverbs 3:9** Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce...

12. **Luke 16:11** If then you have not been faithful in the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches?

13. **1 Timothy 5:8** But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

14. **Proverbs 10:4** Lazy hands make for poverty, but diligent hands bring wealth.

15. **Deuteronomy 8:18** You shall remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth, that he may confirm his covenant that he swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

16. **Romans 13:8** Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.

17. **Matthew 6:33** But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

18. **Proverbs 13:11** Wealth gained hastily will dwindle, but whoever gathers little by little will increase it.

19. **Ecclesiastes 7:12** Wisdom is a shelter as money is a shelter, but the advantage of knowledge is this: Wisdom preserves those who have it.

20. **Proverbs 19:17** Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will repay him for his deed.

Section Three: Scriptures on Giving - bible verses on financial breakthrough

22. **Matthew 6:2** "So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full.

23. **Luke 6:30** Give to everyone who asks you, and if anyone takes what belongs to you, do not demand it back.

24. **Proverbs 3:27** Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in your power to act.

25. **2 Corinthians 9:11** You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

26. **Proverbs 11:25** A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

27. **Luke 6:30** "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

28. **2 Chronicles 29:14** "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.

29. **Deuteronomy 15:10** Give generously to them and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the Lord your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to.

30. **Deuteronomy 16:17** Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the Lord your God that he has given you.

Section Four: Scriptures on God's Provision - bible verses on financial breakthrough

31. **Philippians 4:19** And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

32. **2 Corinthians 9:8** And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.

33. **Matthew 6:31-32** Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all.

34. **Psalm 37:25** I have been young, and now am old, yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken or his children begging for bread.

35. **Psalm 23:1** The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.

36. **Matthew 7:11** If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

37. **Psalm 34:10** The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing.

38. **Luke 12:24** Consider the ravens: they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!

39. **Hebrews 13:5** Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

40. **Job 38:41** Who provides for the raven its prey, when its young ones cry to God for help, and wander about for lack of food?

41. **2 Peter 1:3** His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence...

42. **Luke 12:7** Why, even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not; you are of more value than many sparrows.

43. **John 10:10** The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

44. **Romans 8:32** He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

45. **Matthew 7:7** "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

Prayer for Financial Breakthrough: Lord, thank you that you graciously provide all my needs according to your riches in glory (Philippians 4:19). Thank you that I am worth more than many sparrows. If you provide for the birds of the air, help me to trust that you will provide and meet the needs of me and my family. Section Five: Scriptures on Eternal Rewards - bible verses on financial breakthrough

46. **2 Corinthians 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

47. **Revelation 22:12** "Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done.

48. **Matthew 25:21** His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'

49. **Luke 12:33-34** Sell your possessions and give to the poor. Provide purses for yourselves that will not wear out, a treasure in heaven that will never fail, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

50. **Matthew 6:3-4** But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

51. **2 Timothy 4:7-8** I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.
